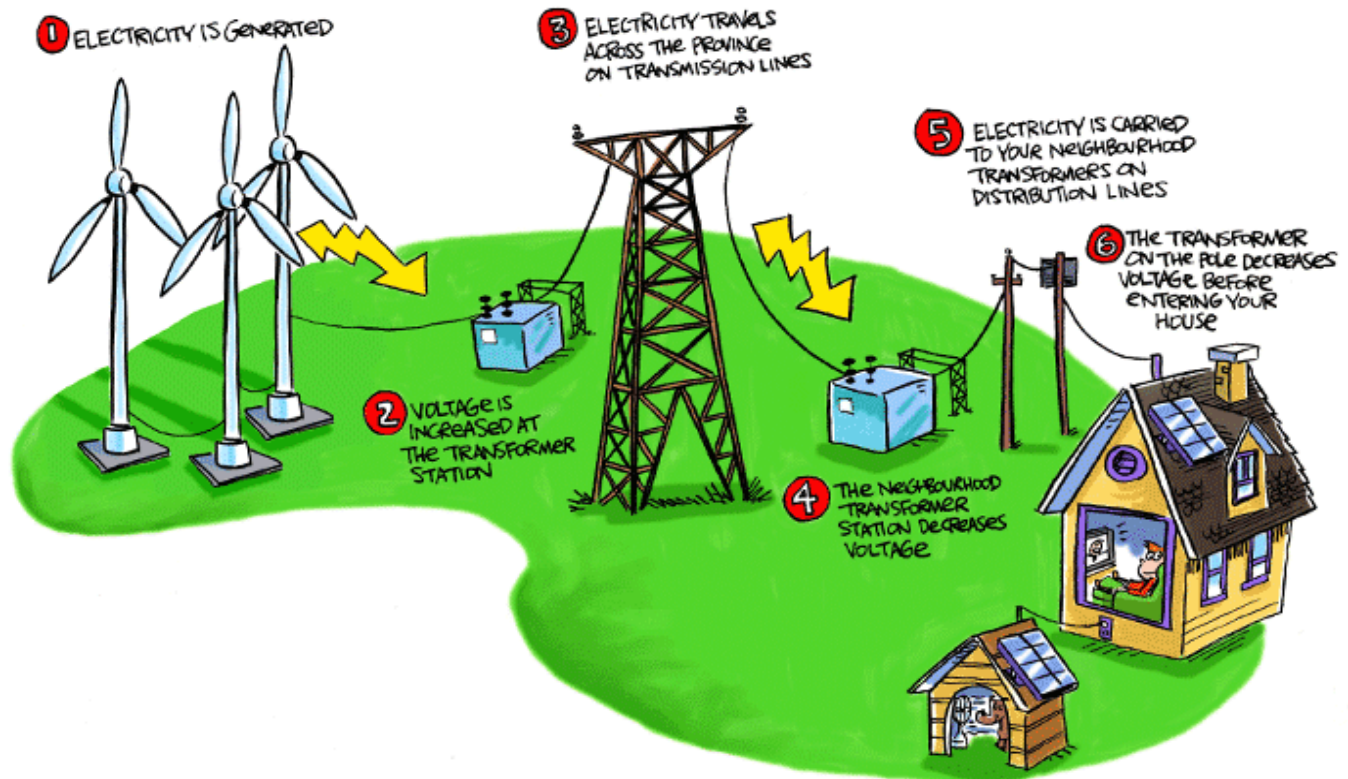


# HOW ELECTRICITY GETS TO YOUR HOME



## DID YOU KNOW?

A Kilowatt (kW) is a unit for measuring electrical power. 1,000 watts = 1 kilowatt. What's a Kilowatt hour? It's the energy consumed when using 1,000 watts of electricity for one full hour.
